won over his opponent John McCain.<sup>2</sup>

It is also alleged that illegal votes could have tipped North Carolina's 2008 presidential vote in favor of Barack Obama.<sup>3</sup> Voter identification laws were identified as not effective in preventing voter fraud, according to the research.
